Taylor & Walker attorney obtains favorable verdict in motorcycle accident case.

Henrico County - Taylor & Walker attorney Benjamin Owings represented a driver who pulled into traffic in front of a plaintiff who was riding a motorcycle. Plaintiff was thrown from his bike and suffered a grade 3 separated shoulder. Plaintiff recovered full use of his arm and shoulder, but was left with a prominent, and permanent, bump on his left shoulder where the clavicle remained out of place. At a jury trial in Henrico County Circuit Court, plaintiff's treating physician testified that the bump was permanent, but that there were no restrictions on physical activity. He further testified that the injury was fairly common, one suffered by 90% of all NFL quarterbacks. Before trial, plaintiff's last settlement demand was \$66,000. Defendant's last offer was \$11,500. The jury returned a verdict of \$7,000.
